Let's look at some of these more closely:

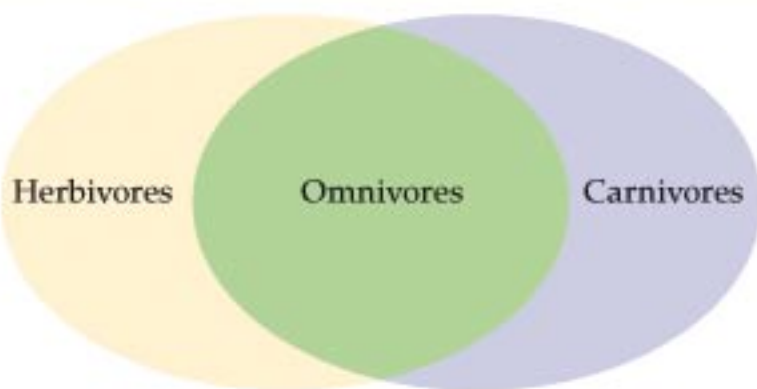
Food

Remember, the herbivores (eat plants), carnivores (eat meat), and omnivores (eat both plants and meat)?



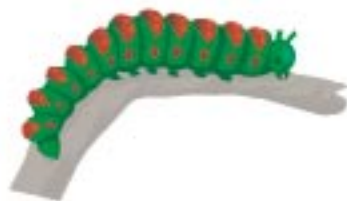
Think of some herbivores you might know about:
