### California Content Standards — Grade 2

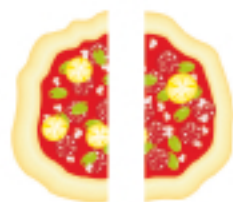
- 4.1 Recognize, name, and compare unit fractions from  $\frac{1}{12}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$ .
- 4.2 Recognize fractions of a whole and parts of a group (e.g., one-fourth of a pie, two-thirds of 15 balls).
- 4.3 Know that when all fractional parts are included, such as four-fourths, the result is equal to the whole and to one.

### Student Exercise:

#### Half

A fraction is an equal part of a whole thing.

This pizza has been cut into 2 equal parts.  
Each part is called a half or  $\frac{1}{2}$



It is one out of two equal pieces.

Here is a box of 6 eggs.



If we split them into two equal parts, we would have 3 eggs in each part.

So half of the box would have 3 eggs and the other half would have 3 eggs

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ box} = 3 \text{ eggs}$$
